Subject: 2019 CACFP National Professional Association Conference

The biennial CACFP National Professional Association (NPA) Conference will be held June 11 – 13, 2019 at the Madison Concourse Hotel in Madison, Wisconsin.

The conference offers an opportunity for State Agency staff responsible for administering the CACFP to receive training on implementation of the meal pattern, gain the latest updates on Federal policies and requirements and engage State agency colleagues in meaningful discussions about Program issues and opportunities.

The conference will cover a range of important topics related to the CACFP and examine how State administrators can respond to the challenges of delivering a quality Program. U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) staff will be present throughout the conference and are scheduled to speak at several sessions. Topics to be addresses at the conference include:

- Meal Pattern Implementation
- Financial Management Recordkeeping and Documentation
- Being Successful in the CACFP
- Serious Deficiency Process
- At-Risk / After School and Seamless Summer Programs
- Sponsors of Unaffiliated Sites

The conference will include an informational session on the CACFP Operational Resources & Education (CORE) trainings. Continuing education credits will be available for all three days of the conference.
